"Way of the Master" Script

CONSCIENCE

(Life & Death, Right & Wrong, Black & White)

- 1. Would you say you're a good person?
- 2. <u>Do</u> you think you've kept the Ten Commandments?
- 3. If God <u>Judges</u> you by His Ten Commandments, would you be innocent or guilty?
- 4. What do you think your <u>Destiny</u> is heaven or hell?

Does that concern you?

If Yes: Give them The Gospel

If No: Thank them and move on (or offer inner healing).

URGENCY

CONVERSATION STARTERS

Swinging to the things of God

(Switches the mind from the intellect to the conscience)

- What do you think happens after you die?
- Do you have a Christian background?

o If yes:

- Do you ever get out and share your faith?
- Have them tell you how to get to heaven. (Try to get them off track to see if they can get back to Jesus.)

OIf no:

- Do you hope there's a heaven? Who do you think goes there?
- Would you say that good people go to heaven and bad people go to hell?
- I'm taking a class on how easy it is to talk to people about God. Would you be my example for this week?

DETAILED SCRIPT QUESTIONS

1. Would you say you're a good person?

2. Do you think you've kept the Ten Commandments?

- The ninth commandment says "Thou shall not Lie." Have you ever told a lie? Me too (lots of them). What are we called when we tell lies? <u>Liar</u>
- The eighth commandment says "Thou shall not steal." Have you ever stolen something, no matter how small? Me too (tons of stuff). What are we called when we take things that don't belong to us? <u>Thief</u>
- The third commandment says "Thou shall not use God's name in vain." Have you ever used God's name in vain? Me too (lots of times). That's called <u>Blasphemy</u>, and it's very serious to God.
- O The seventh commandment says "Thou shall not commit adultery", but God says "If you've even looked with lust, you've committed <u>adultery</u> in your heart." Have you ever had a sexual thought about someone? Me too.
- (Person's Name), you've just told me you're a liar, a thief, a blasphemer, and an adulterer at heart.

3. So, if God <u>Judges</u> you by the Ten Commandments, would you be innocent or guilty?

(If they want you to prove God's existence, they got off the conscience.) Use the "Painting, Building, Creation" analogy.

• God says, no murderer, no adulterer, no liar, no thief, shall inherit the Kingdom of God.

4. So, what do you think your <u>Destiny</u> is, heaven or hell?

If they do any <u>justifying</u>, answer it and segue back to the commandments. If they say "MY god would..." (justifying), tell them:

That's exactly what I said, and do you know what you've just done? You've just broken the Second Commandment, "Thou shall create no graven image" -- creating a god to suit yourself -- one that lets you lie, steal, blaspheme, and commit adultery. So now you are 0 for 5.

(Then make them answer Question #4.)

Does that concern you?

IF YES: Give them The Gospel

- After giving a <u>concise</u> gospel message, quote ROM 10:9
- Create Urgency
- Offer to pray with them

IF NO: Thank them and move on, or offer an inner healing.
